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

Engaged in the RSP and implementing regenerative agricultural practices.





Where the program is currently being implemented including Belgium, France, Germany, India, Italy, Poland, Portugal, Serbia, Spain, United States and Vietnam.



Including a total of 6,500 ha of agricultural land benefitted (4.300 ha of cover crops; 120 ha of flower strips; 28 ha of hedgerows and afforested areas; 20 ha of restored water habitats; +150 birds & bat boxes and beehives)

Being produced under regenerative agriculture approach including spices, onion, carrot, parsley, beet root, green bean, garlic, tomato, parsnip, celery, leek, spinach, and many more.
